

STARTING A NEW CHILD CARE BUSINESS?

THE USDA CHILD CARE FOOD PROGRAM AND PROVIDERS CHOICE CAN HELP!



USDA offers financial support to eligible Child Care Providers who are starting a new child care business. The money would help a provider meet licensing requirements in order to participate on the Child and Adult Care Food Program (CACFP), which in turn would provide even more financial support to your business.

How much money could I be eligible for?

You could receive up to \$200.00 toward the following licensing costs:

- up to \$90.00 toward license application and background check fees
- up to \$65.00 for an approved fire extinguisher
- up to \$45.00 for an approved smoke detector

(Receipts for actual expenditures are required. You will receive reimbursement after the submission of your first Food Program claim.)

How do I apply?

Just complete and submit the three items to PCI to receive reimbursement toward licensing costs:

1. An application and agreement to apply to the CACFP under PCI's sponsorship.
2. A Household Income Statement (which qualifies the provider according to USDA family size and income guidelines).
3. A statement from the county licensor describing the necessary equipment and licensing fees the provider will need to complete the licensing process.
